## Coughs and sneezes spread diseases!





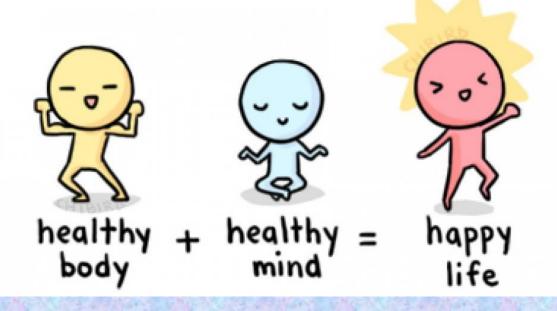


















## **Thought of the Day**
