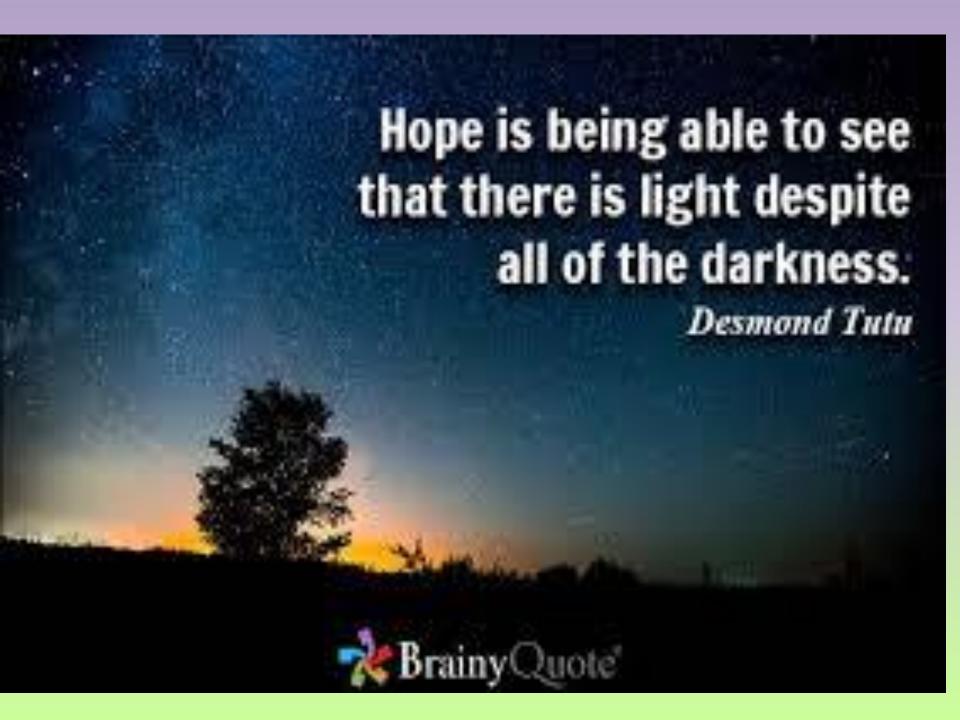
What is hope?

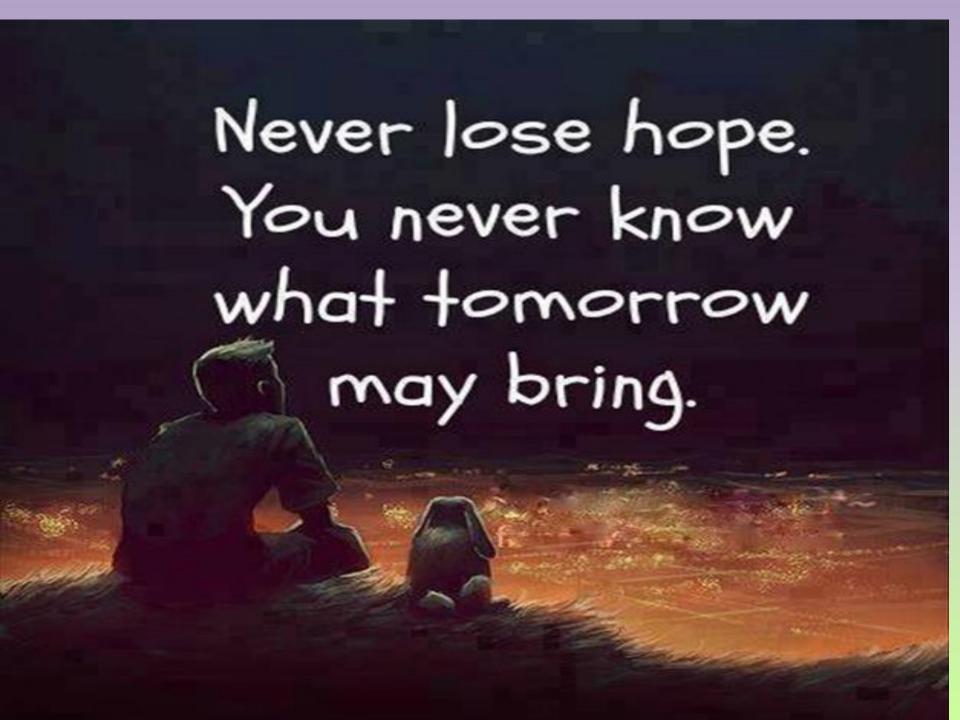


Hope is believing and staying positive
