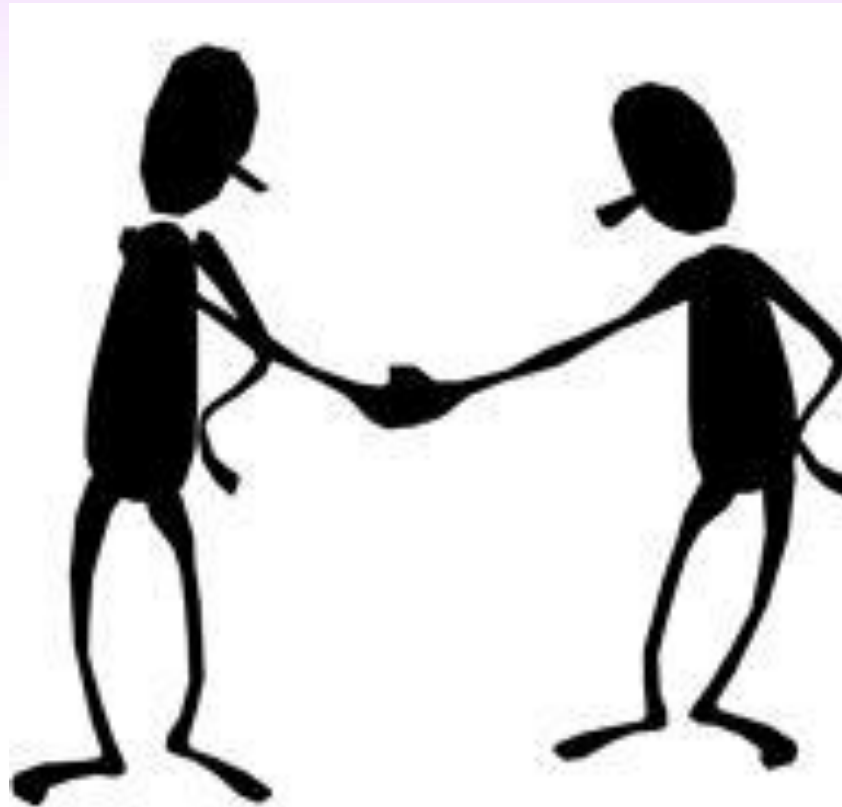

RESPECT



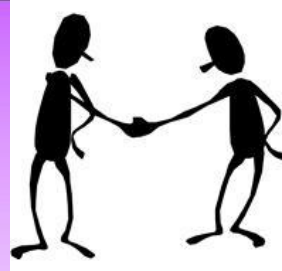
RESPECT

Do we like people to break or spoil our things?

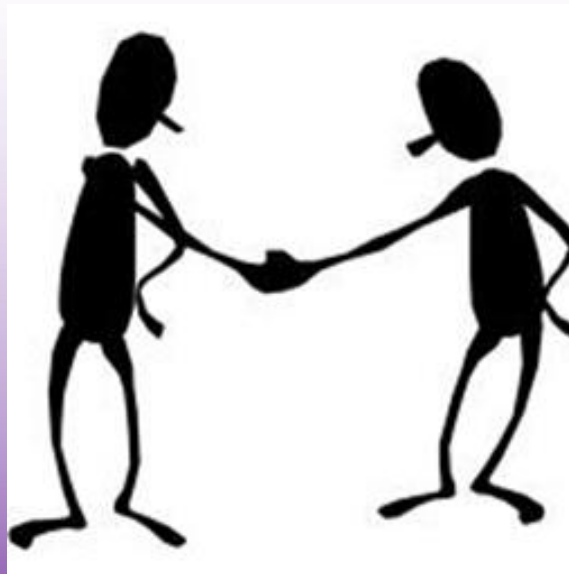
Do we like people to mess up our special places?
