# What will we eat?

Breakfast: Fruit juice, cereals, toast with butter/jam

Lunch: Sandwiches along with crisps, fruit and drink

Evening meal: Cooked meals such as pizza, burgers, sausages, fish, chips, jacket potatoes etc. pasta / baked potato, vegetables. On Thursday night it will be a Christmas dinner.

Supper: A hot chocolate or squash with a biscuit or cake.

All children will go to collect their own dinner and choose what they would like to eat from what is available.

- If there are any special dietary requirements, please see a member of staff at the end of the meeting and we can ensure that these are catered for as best as possible during the trip.

# Where will the children be sleeping?

- The children will be sleeping in a large dormitory in a bunk bed. Boys will sleep on one corridor and girls on another.
- The showers are right outside the dormitory.
- The teachers will be located near to the dormitories so if there are any emergencies we are easy to get to! Staff regularly check in on the children during the night.
- Children gain great independence as they make their own beds every morning and get themselves ready for the day.



# What if they miss home?

- The children will be able to bring a teddy or a special item that reminds you of home (no games, mobile phones or electronics)
- When the children are at Edgmond Hall you will not be able to ring home or vice versa.
- The school will contact parents via text to let you know when the children have arrived safely. We will also text to let you know an approximate return time on their last day. We will try and upload photos on the school website while we are there but the wifi signal is not amazing.

# What to Pack

## KIT CHECK LIST

### In main bag/holdall:

NB: Children need to be able to carry this to upstairs bedrooms.

- 2 pairs long trousers
- 2 jumpers or fleeces
- A shirt per day
- Shorts/t-shirts (summer)
- Socks, some long/thick
- Underwear
- Sleepwear
- Slippers if you want
- Trainers
- Towel
- Wash kit-toothbrush, toothpaste, comb/brush, soap, flannel
- Reading book if you want



### In small rucksack/sports bag:

- Waterproof top/coat
- Wellies
- 2 plastic carrier bags for boots/dirty clothes
- Spare jumper or fleece
- Torch (autumn/winter)
- Hat/gloves/scarf (winter)
- Sun hat/sun cream (summer)
- Camera if you want
- Drinks/water container

- For our Christmas party and dinner, children will need a Christmas jumper.
- Plenty of warm jumpers and socks.
- Water bottle
- Make sure your child can carry their suitcase.

- Thorough risk assessments will be completed for the trip.
- We are aware of medication in school and medical needs and these have been considered.
- If your child has any prescribed medication which they will/may require whilst they are at Edgmond, please bring it to school and complete the relevant forms with a first aider.
